CYH Mites crowned Bay State champs

Two Canton Youth Hockey Mite-level teams — Canton Green and Canton White — took home Bay State Hockey League titles last week after going unbeaten throughout the playoffs in their respective division tournaments.

The Green team, led by coaches James Galanis and Wes Rawding, won all four of its postseason games to capture the U8 Silver Division crown, culminating with a finals win over the South Shore Seahawks Yellow team at the Bog Arena in Kingston. Entering as the No. 4 seed, Canton Green was one of four CYH squads in the 16-team division and knocked off the Canton Mite Blue team in the tournament quarterfinals. Another Canton club, the Mite Black team, also challenged for the title and finished second in the division in total victories this season behind only Canton Green (22-6-3).

In the U8 Bronze Division, the Canton Mite White team put together a dominant campaign, outscoring opponents 201-89 en route to the No. 1 overall seed. After a first-round bye, the team earned wins over Hanover and Duxbury before clinching the title with a victory over the South Shore Seahawks Red team. Led by coaches Pat McCloud, Vinny Civian and Paul Hynes, the Mite White team lost only two games all season and finished with a record of 20-2-1 between the regular season and playoffs.
